## Conservation and Management in Freshwaters

## David Aldridge, Dawson Professor of Zoology University of Cambridge

David's work focuses on applied freshwater ecology, with a particular emphasis on bivalve molluscs. His particular interests are the conservation of rare species and threatened ecosystems, the biology and control of invasive species, and the use of biological processes to develop sustainable remediation and monitoring programmes for degraded waterbodies. A considerable part of his work involves collaboration with the water industry, government agencies and NGOs, and these collaborations provide a significant part of his research funding.
